












Hosting with Applause? We are here to help.

At Applause, we are passionate about bringing the very best, high-quality shows directly to your community! We understand the value of the arts in bringing communities together and we are always excited to welcome new hosts into the Applause family. Whether you've hosted 100 shows or this is your first, we are pleased to be working with you and we are here to help.

If you're new to hosting an Applause show at your event we try and make the process of booking as easy as possible. We've listed the key steps for you below to give you an idea of what to expect and what you might want to think about. Applause uses its funding to subsidise the cost of the shows which are on a sliding scale starting at £200.

- 1. Browse the menu. Take a look at what is on offer this season and create a shortlist of three shows you would like to book for your event and submit your request to Applause to touring@applause.org.uk. If you're unsure of what shows would work well for your audience or you would like to find out more about them, then we are more than happy to have a chat and advise.
- 2. Applause will liaise with the artists to agree dates, draw up the contracts so you can focus on making your event as successful as possible.
- 3. Get everything ready. Make sure that you have everything in place for your event, such as licenses, insurance, risk assessment etc. Think about wraparound activity.

- **4. Market the event**. The Applause team are on hand to help and have lots of handy tips on how to market the show.
- 5. Enjoy the show! On the day of your event we will ask you to help us collect some audience feedback (this is really important in helping us to secure our funding and continue to support shows like yours).
- 6. After the event. We will also ask you to complete some feedback about your experience.

For our new commissions we can't guarantee their availability before 1 May, but you can book any of our returning favourites if your event is before this date.

Boswell, probably the most popular singer you've never heard of. Performed by Daryl Beeton, It's Classic Connee will combine Connee's music, comedy and ravishing outfits to create the usual offbeat performance style that Daryl & Co have become known for.

Inspired by the life of Connee Boswell, a famous voice of radio who's recordings sold over 75 million copies and was one of the brightest stars of American popular music in the first half of the 20th century, but Connee had to keep a big secret and so got left behind by the new golden age of TV and Film.

We've all at some point had to hide something about ourselves in order to fit in or had to play by other people's rules and this show will challenge those reasons and champion just being ourselves. It's Classic Connee plays with the illusion of perceived beauty, identity and fame to create a playful, tactile and enjoyable family show that will make us see things differently.




Devious Dolphins

Dolphins is a comedy walkabout show created by the team who brought us Treefellas. Two actors dressed in giant Dolphin costumes equipped with some special effects such hidden water sprays, communicate nonverbally through whistle sounds and water spraying. Highly intelligent and naughty these mammals show off their tricks and also reverse the relationship between human and animal - they will tame their public, make audience members jump through hoops and catch them in their big nets.

Devious Dolphins is a very playful and interactive performance piece which gently satirises the relationship of humans with nature. The Dophin couple also have a dolphin hand puppet which will help to connect with very young children. The Dolphins become the trainers rewarding the humans with a mobile phone or giant fake bank notes at the end of the stick.

Environmental issues will lie underneath all the comedic playfulness without ever trying to teach or making an issue-based piece. Darker scenes include the Dolphins fighting with rubbish and oil sheets. By seeing these vulnerable sea creatures on land, we hopefully raise awareness in a subtle way and make the audience laugh at the same time. **Commissioned by Applause**

Poems Made from Words Found in the Bin


Poems Made from Words Found in the Bin is part performance, part creative writing workshop, and a digital art intervention.

Members of the public are invited to join Rhiannon in creating poems made from shredded documents which are then animated and added to a growing collection. The animated poems are uploaded onto the Slow GIF Movement channel on Giphy (with 39 million views), which allows your poem to be read and shared globally on messaging apps and social media. 


