























Hosting with Applause? We are here to help.

At Applause, we are passionate about bringing the very best, high-quality shows directly to your community! We understand the value of the arts in bringing communities together and we are always excited to welcome new hosts into the Applause family. Whether you've hosted 100 shows or this is your first, we are pleased to be working with you and we are here to help.

If you're new to hosting an Applause show at your event we try and make the process of booking as easy as possible. We've listed the key steps for you below to give you an idea of what to expect and what you might want to think about. Applause uses its funding to subsidise the cost of the shows which are on a sliding scale starting at £200.

- 1. Browse the menu. Take a look at what is on offer this season and create a shortlist of three shows you would like to book for your event and submit your request to Applause to touring@applause.org.uk. If you're unsure of what shows would work well for your audience or you would like to find out more about them, then we are more than happy to have a chat and advise.
- 2. Applause will liaise with the artists to agree dates, draw up the contracts so you can focus on making your event as successful as possible.
- **3. Get everything ready.** Make sure that you have everything in place for your event, such as licenses, insurance, risk assessment etc. Think about wraparound activity.

- **4. Market the event**. The Applause team are on hand to help and have lots of handy tips on how to market the show.
- **5. Enjoy the show!** On the day of your event we will ask you to help us collect some audience feedback (this is really important in helping us to secure our funding and continue to support shows like yours).
- **6. After the event**. We will also ask you to complete some feedback about your experience.

For our new commissions we can't guarantee their availability before 1 May, but you can book any of our returning favourites if your event is before this date.

Never A GULL Moment


Never A GULL Moment is an entertaining and interactive walkabout act from Feasible Ferret Theatre, the makers of The Dustbusters.

Prepare to get in a flap and ruffle some feathers with interactive puppetry, physical and verbal comedy. Emoto-Matic

Emoto-matic is a hilarious new show, with music, clowning and audience participation. Audiences watch a live demonstration of how to extract and bottle unwanted emotions, from a team of haphazard scientists. Exploring themes of feelings, how important it is to express yourself, and men showing their emotions, this funny, family show will have the whole audience disco dancing and laughing around your event.

Our haphazard scientists will walkabout to engage with the audience before the eccentric doctor demonstrates his new invention, The Emotomatic, a bottling machine that will extract unnecessary emotion and bottle it up, literally, so you can take it away. Out of sight, out of mind! With smoke machine, sound effects, live music, clowning, slap-stick comedy, the audience laugh as volunteers come and try out the machine, and of course much chaos and confusion arises when the machine malfunctions and emotions pour out everywhere.

The show concludes with a strong and joyful message about expressing yourself, a participatory disco dance for the whole audience, and a celebration of the power of our emotions.

Performed by Four Eyed Theatre, a young, all male company, interested in exploring issues for young people and challenging stereotypes, this show is full of slapstick, music, and audience participation, and suitable for any event, any floor or ground and any audience.

ARCADE Mini by Casson & Friends is an interactive performance with dance 'games', that animate public spaces - encouraging playful participation to connect people of all ages with the childlike joy of play - and each other!

Each performance lasts approximately 30 minutes and contains 6 unique games - each announced on our giant scoreboard!

The games are elegantly played and facilitated by our friendly team of highly skilled performers. Half of the games are WATCH US (mesmerising & fun to watch), and the other half are JOIN US (inviting gentle playful participation). The show has a fun and bouncy electronic soundtrack and is suitable for all ages

Suitable for a range of public spaces (parks, squares, festivals) and for all flat-ish surfaces (grass, concrete etc.) No participant sign-up is required games are 'turn up & play' - simple and easy to engage with.

Games are non-competitive with a focus on 'playing to play' rather than 'playing to win' and can be joined for anything from 30 seconds in passing to a full round of a few minutes - and can be left at any time. We strive to make ARCADE Mini as inclusive as possible and our teams are trained in access support to enable the widest possible participation!



Rust & Stardust

Doris Drake and Daria the Dragon

A walkabout act combining puppetry and vibrant visual theatre, encouraging audiences to be kind to animals and preserve natural habitats, with a gentle ecological angle about the effects of climate change on the natural world.

The act has a loose walkabout structure which will create a relaxed and informal environment for interacting with audiences and allowing for photo opportunities which in our experience is very popular. There is a participatory element: audiences will be invited to interact with the dragon puppet, with children encouraged to stroke the puppet to build trust, and there will be some group participation too, with a magical wish making activity where the dragon breathes glittering dream dust and grants wishes.

The act can be flexible to slot into event programmes and is suitable for multiple performances throughout a day. As the act is walkabout, encounters with audiences will be up close, meaning competing noise is not an issue, and the dragon is large and eyecatching.

The Ukulele **Apothecary**

The bright colours and the vintage style of the Ukulele Apothecary will likely catch your eye! If not, you'll probably hear them coming, playing their ukuleles and trumpet kazoos as they stride into view looking for people to make friends with, bring a smile to, pass the joy to.

Instead of dispensing herbs and medicine like a traditional apothecary, these clowns dispense music and silliness. Stopping for a short while with an individual or couple, staying longer with a larger family group or allowing people to gather around them.

First they need to check vital statistics, give you the once over. Check your wellness with their stethoscopes, blood pressure monitors and put you through some rigorous reaction tests (catching balls, timed star jumps, press ups, singing different notes, copying a dance move) until they finally decide on the perfect remedy for you. A song. It will always be a song!

You will then be serenaded with humour and harmony. Perhaps their work will then be done or perhaps more musical medicine will be required.

In most cases it will be vital for you and your group to learn to play the ukulele too. With just a couple of simple chords a song can be played and a new skill is begun.

Memories with Connor

Memories with Connor is an interactive photo kiosk that uses storytelling and immersive performative art to open a dialogue on the often-relatable experience of forgetfulness. The experience takes around 2 minutes and is suitable for 12+ or younger with assistance. The kiosk can also accommodate multiple participants at a time so families and younger audiences can have fun together.

The screens, lighting and audio instantly change, transporting them into a new memory waiting to be made. The user appears alongside Connor in real-time on the screen through digital AI composition. They are photographed as they explore and build new memories, the memories are then printed automatically!

Whilst the kiosk can operate autonomously, lab-coat-clad booth technicians are typically on hand to check for coin authenticity, help with memory selection, and review new memories.

The kiosk is self-contained in an industrial gazebo that protects the work and audience from heavy rain and wind and features memory menus, spinning signs, 400+ interactive LEDs, playful buttons, and dynamic sounds. If access to power is not available we can bring our own generator.

Cracking the **Crinoline**

Cracking the Crinoline will deliver a short, sharp, surprising sting. Combining crinolines, corsets and boxing boots, our Queen B's remind us not to take older women for granted. The piece is visually vibrant, uplifting, and will leave audiences reaching for their Marigolds.

The performance starts with an apologetic walkabout and proceeds to place older women centre stage, challenging perceptions of what it means to be an older woman, ageism, and misogyny. As the piece progresses, the performers transform from dainty, well-behaved biddies to loud and proud women. At the end, where appropriate, the ladies invite the audience to join them 'on stage' to learn the 'Company Stomp' which engages onlookers and enriches the sense of the shared experience.

The piece is ripe and relevant in relation to current debate around gender imbalance and the injustices served on women #MeToo. Audiences have been thrilled and excited to see older women take over the streets and surprised by the power of the piece.

The Puppet Petting Farm is latest edition to HandMade Theatre's Puppet Busking series. These small-scale puppet shows are perfect for community festivals, alternative spaces and walkabout style event offering the chance for audiences to get up close to our delightful puppets and join them in a highly interactive way.

The show lasts c. 20 minutes and is suited to a small designated performance space with mats provided for audiences. We also do 5-10 minutes walkabout interaction either side to gather audience and allow informal fun and photos at the end.

The petting farm theme is recognisable to all and this show offers the opportunity to meet a range of loveable animal character puppets. Children love to interact with them. Adults enjoy the clever mechanics, the beautiful construction and seeing the fun had by their children. The live music and original songs add dynamics to each character and pulls together an audience. All our puppets are beautifully handcrafted from sustainable materials and are designed to be touched by audiences. The cow is a large scale head. The chicken small, fluffy and great to feed. The piglet is hand held, while the Goat is full size.



Performed by Daryl Beeton, this show combines music, comedy and audience interaction to tell a story of being forced to fit into the unforgiving world of fame and ends with Connee realising she can finally just be herself. She casts off the coat of secrecy that has kept her hidden for so many years before heading off into her reclaimed world of stardom… and of course finally signing a few autographs as she leaves!

The Library at the Edge of the World

The Library at the Edge of the World will be a magical pop-up interactive show and writing experience for young audiences of all backgrounds that celebrates the power of stories to reconnect us to the world around us.

Its curious larger-than-life puppet librarian will transform any location, expressing herself in actions not words and irresistibly inviting audiences to join her mission - a mission to create a home for the stories of the world's most overlooked inhabitants. Each of the books she has carefully catalogued will bring to life, through vivid puppetry and sound, the story of the overlooked living things around us: from woodlice to fungi, to trees, kelp and crows.

Children will be supported to decide together which of the books will be opened - whose story will be told. Each chosen book will open into a different world of quality puppetry and a bit of theatrical magic. We will see how hearing the stories transforms the library - how their choices can change the world - all children will then be invited to create miniature books that share the stories of creatures they love. The books can be drawn and visual storytelling or cartoons, or written in words in any languages children feel at home in.



Afterwards they will be invited to lodge their books in the library, where they can create a unique display - and take home a blank book to produce another story with their families. The project aims to empower children through connection with their natural world, supporting them to become creative advocates for it themselves.


